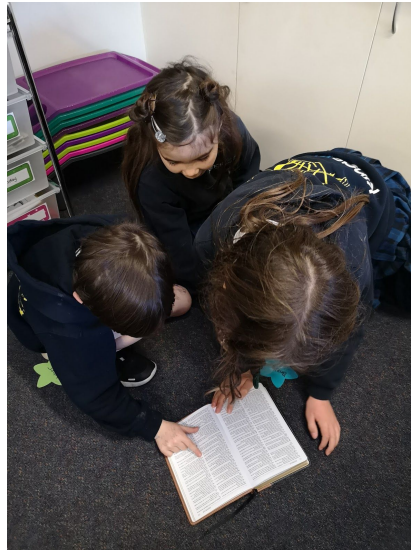
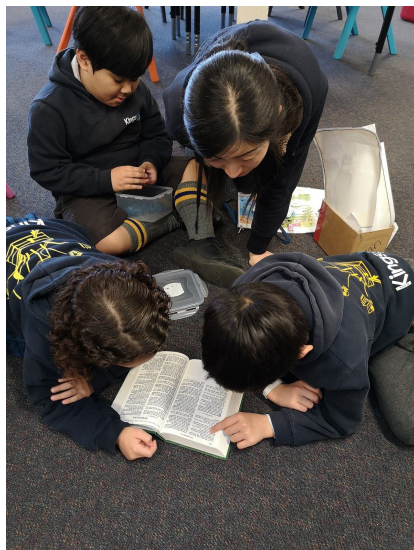
Next Friday Room 3 will run a special assembly for the end of term. They have had an interesting inquiry this term and are excited to share the games they have created as part of their studies.

### **Park and Ride**
